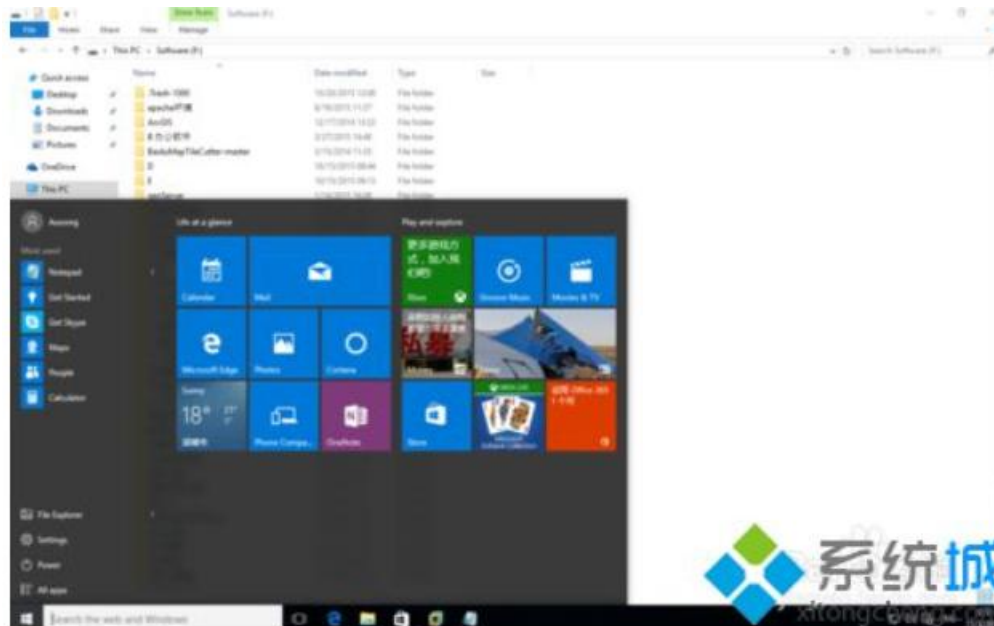
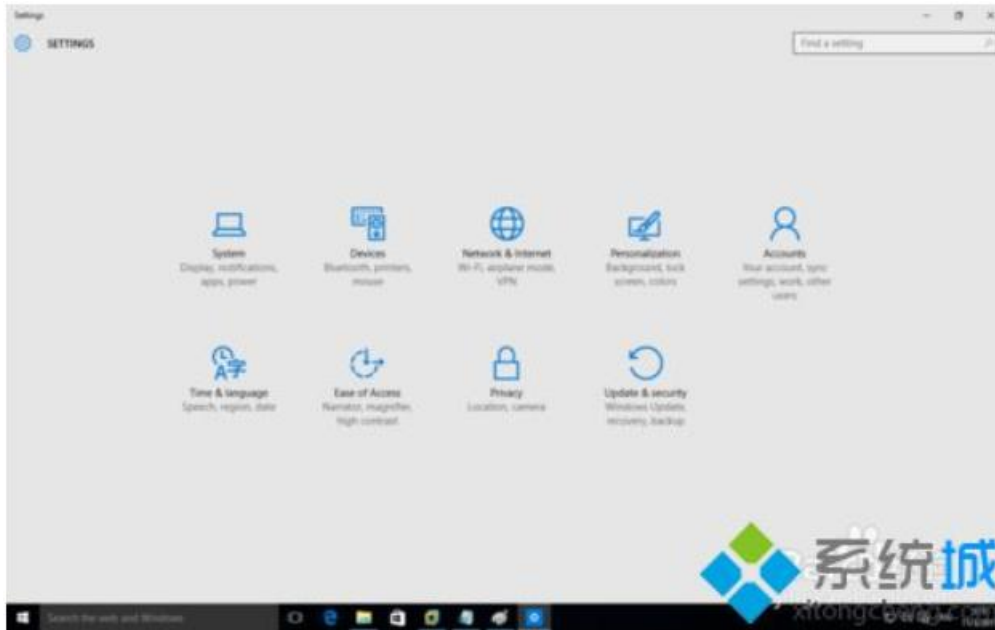


## Please follow the following steps:

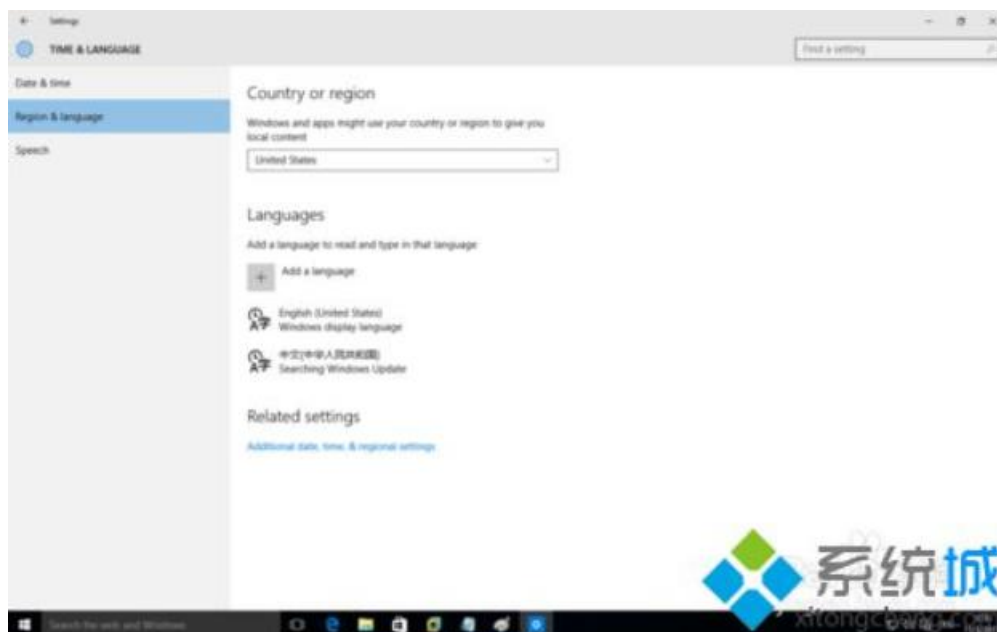
1. Click the start menu and select the settings menu.



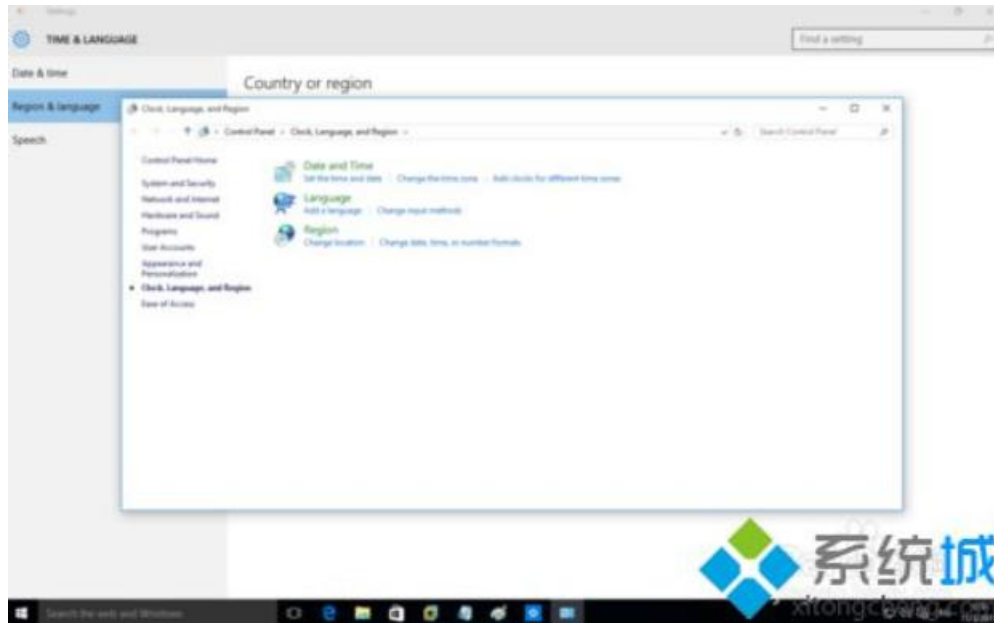
2. In the settings dialog box, click time & language.



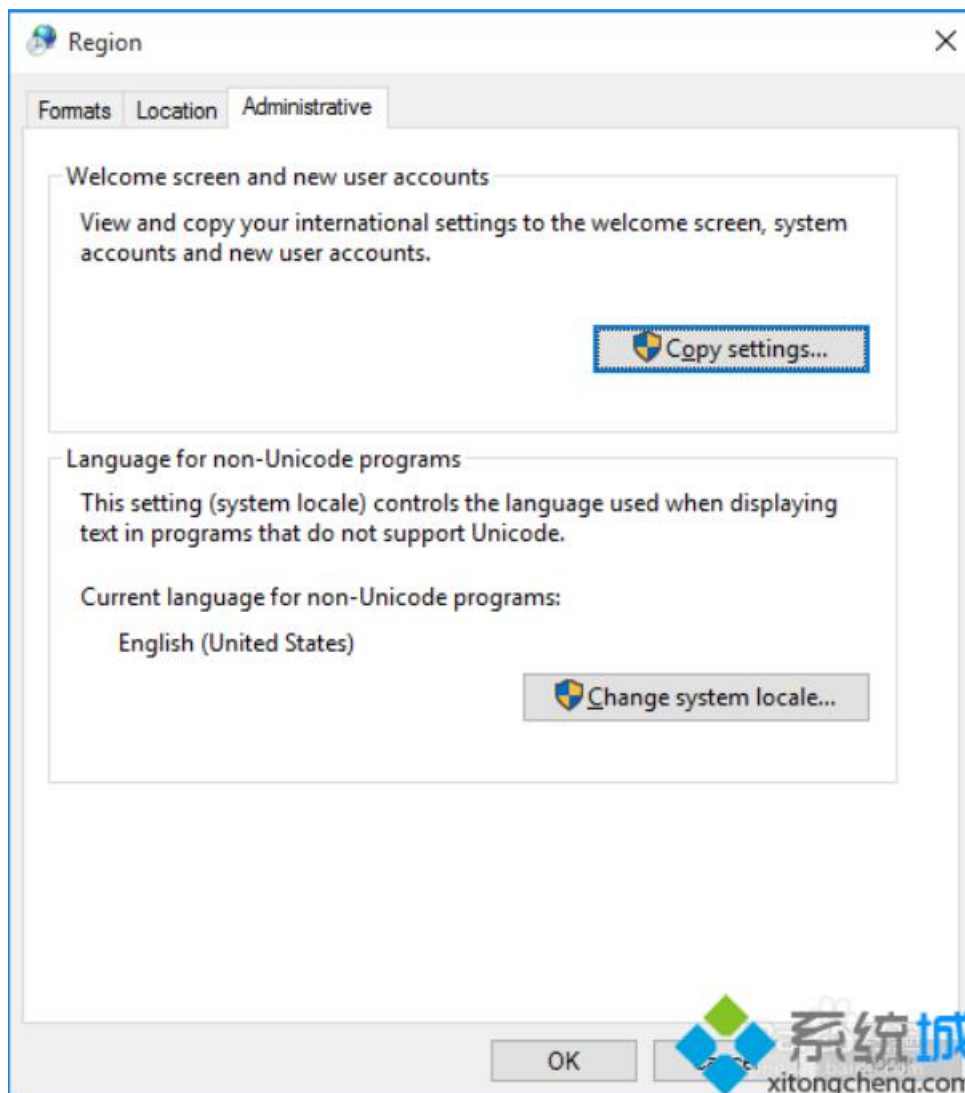
3. In the time & language option, click region & Language on the left. Then click additional date, time on the right, ® ional settings.



4. Does the window open feel familiar? This is the control panel. Click Change location.

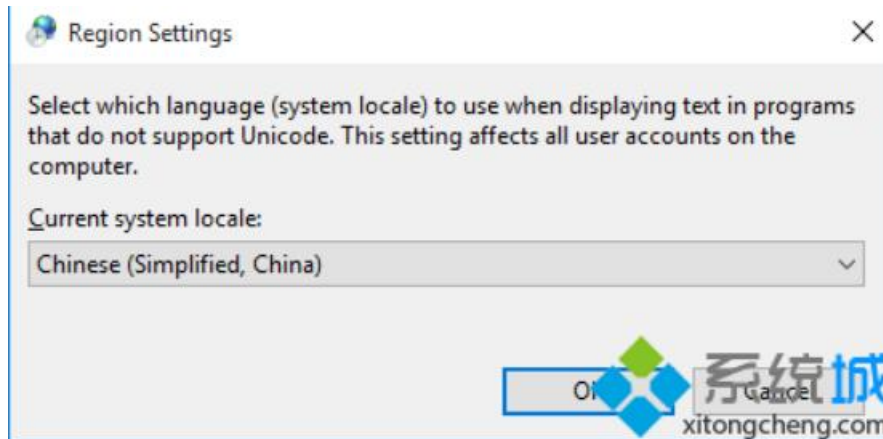


5. In the region dialog box, click the administrative tab. Click change system location below.
